Directions to Phyllis Maddox's home:

55 Hillside Ave. is between Appleton St. and Florence Ave.

Follow Mass. Ave. to Park Ave. in Arlington Heights. Take Park toward Rt. 2 for 2 blocks to Appleton. Turn right on Appleton for one block to Hillside, then turn left on Hillside. 55 is the 3rd house on the right with a front porch and a large yew bush in the front yard.

If you are coming down Park Avenue from the south, take a left on Florence, then the first right on Hillside. 55 is about 8 houses down on your left.



## Lights! Camera! Take Action! LWVMA Second Annual Student Video Contest Kicks off Feb. 1

LWVMA is proud to announce that its second annual student video contest will kick off on February 1. The theme of this year's contest is, "There Oughta Be A Law!"

What is the Student Video Contest? A new two-year session of the Massachusetts state legislature just opened in January. LWVMA is inviting Massachusetts high school students to submit two-minute videos letting our state legislators know what new laws should be passed to keep Massachusetts a great state. We want to hear student ideas about education, the environment, crime--you name it!

Who can enter? The contest is open to any Massachusetts high school student in grades 9-12.

When is the contest? Entries may be submitted online at http://lwvma.org starting February 1. The deadline for submissions is March 31. Judging will take place in April, and winners will be announced in May.

**Are there prizes?** Yes! First place wins \$1000; second place wins \$500; and third place wins \$250.

What can you and your members do? We need League volunteers to help publicize the contest at local high schools and community centers. We also need judges and sponsors.
