### In Memoriam: Patricia Ellen Lieberson

Pat Lieberson, a life member of the League of Women Voters of Arlington and longtime Board member, died November 15, 2021. No obituary was published, and we learned of her loss from Jo Anne Preston, who found out quite by chance from a neighbor.

Pat served as Local Action Vice President for many years, until 2012, with a particular focus on environmental issues. She left the Board to focus on caring for her husband Stanley, an emeritus Harvard sociology professor, who died in 2018. But she contributed a great deal to our study of the Arlington Housing Authority. She also led our annual review of Town Meeting warrant articles for many years. Jo Anne Preston reports that Pat was instrumental and very helpful in her own run for the Housing Authority, and reminds us that she was very active in the Mystic River Watershed Association as well as a longtime Town Meeting member.

Meredith Zona, our Organization VP, has these recollections:

Pat joined the Arlington League around 1990, when I was co-president. I remember when I first spoke to her, she said she didn't hear back from the League right away after she submitted her membership application, which was surprising. I explained our membership director had been ill, and she said something like "That explains it, then. The League is always so responsive!"

Pat was also very helpful when my husband and I visited her in her capacity as a SHINE counselor, to get some advice on social services that may be available for my husband's Aunt. His Aunt lived south of Boston, which was outside of Pat's territory for counseling, but she was still very willing to speak with us, and provided excellent advice.

Pat served as a SHINE (Serving the Health Insurance Needs of Everyone) counselor for many years, helping people in the community with guidance about health care programs. She was also active in Vision 2020 (now Envision Arlington).

Carolyn Parsons, Co-President, remembers,

Pat was not an unaggressive driver at least when I was a passenger in her car. Whipping through Cambridge to participate in a Housing Authority tenants' election, she told me that her next car would be a bright color so that she could be seen. I silently agreed that this was a very good idea.

Pat greatly enjoyed being able to look out at the Mystic Lake from her home. At a Legislators' Brunch she expressed her concerns with raw sewerage coming out of a pipe into the lake after a heavy rainstorm. She referred to her front yard being polluted. One of the legislators responded that it really wasn't her front yard. Pat responded that she knew exactly where her front yard was located, and the outfall pipe was most certainly in her front yard.

Kathy Fennelly recalls, "I was always glad when she was on any committee. She added so much wisdom and knowledge. Besides, she was fun and had a booming laugh."

Angela Olszewski, Co-President, says, "I first got to know Pat when I joined the Governance Task Group of Vision 2020. In our later years of membership, we were a tightknit group of five, each of us from a separate decade: Ralph Sexton, Pat, Peter Manning, Sherry Miller, and I. We worked together on several editions of "Settling In: An Introductory Guide to Arlington," a publication that was offered to new residents. We met at Starbucks and always enjoyed each other's company. I subsequently got to know Pat even better through the League and Town Meeting. Pat was passionate about issues that were important to her and always ready to contribute to a project."

Janice Bakey says, "She was irreplaceable on the Housing Study. She just knew so much about Public Housing, and she had a great sense of humor and a good outlook on life in general."

Joan Martin adds, "I always enjoyed her company, especially when she was being a contrarian. She was smart, funny and knew so much about the town. I miss her already."




