

### **Calling All Voter Education Projects!**

### From the State League

The Lotte E. Scharfman Citizen Education Grant Program can help your League cover costs for voter education programs. A Scharfman grant can help with events around elections, candidate forums, Voters Guides, issues meetings, and meet-and-greet with Legislators. Grants can be written for non-election projects, too. Successful Scharfman grants have funded art exhibits, Know Your Town programs, Town Meeting informational handbooks and tech infrastructure like Zoom for voter service programs in our post-pandemic world. Think crea-



tively: if it is a voter service project, it probably meets the guidelines. Need some ideas? Go to the LWVMA for a list of previous grants:

The grant forms are easy to complete and you can get up to \$300 for an individual League. Want to work with two other Leagues? Scharfman grant applications for 3 or more Leagues working together can request up to \$600.

Share your ideas with you local League board. The next grant cycle deadline is April 17. The June grant cycle deadline is June 12. Start planning now or plan for a future event.
